Will compliant bunkers be available in your jurisdiction?

From January 1st, 2020, only low Sulphur content of 0.5% or less can be used at all South Korea ports.

Which government body or organization issues fines for sulphur violations?



Korea Coast Guard (KCG).

What is the estimated potential value of fines?



~ KRW 10,000,000.

Is there a possibility of criminal action for sulphur violations?



Not at the present.

Can a ship be detained for violations?
If so, will a club LOU be accepted to secure its release?



It is possible. Vessels can be released once the fine has been paid.

Is it possible to appeal fines?



Yes.

What contingency measures are available for ships carrying non-compliant fuel.



Port authorities are not allow to enter any Korean port if vessels carry non-compliant fuel but vessels supplied with compliant fuel will be allowed into the port. Recommended to carry compliant fuel to avoid problems.
