Note: It is important to keep in mind that since the canal began to face problems with water levels, many restrictions have changed, therefore the waiting time reflected in our daily report is only a guide to know how many ships/days are waiting to get a slot to transit with reservation. This does not mean that there is a waiting time like in the past where ships waited days and transited based on first come first serve. There is no clear light at the moment if the Panama Canal returns to transit non booked vessels as in the past based on first come first serve.
